



Continuous composting toilet

Continuous systems require space under the floor to locate the composting unit. Each pan requires its own chamber where all waste is received and stored until composting is completed. Organic bulking agents such as sawdust may need to be added to aid the decomposition process. The finished compost is removed and disposed of.

This type of toilet has an air inlet and exhaust which may be driven by convection, electric fan or solar powered fan (generally power consumption is low).
